

## Understanding positive relationships between Disabled People and Community Support Workers in Canterbury

**We would love to hear from disabled people, their family/whānau members, and community support workers about what makes a good relationship between disabled people and community support workers.**

### What will the research involve?

You will share your ideas and thoughts in **two workshops** that will be run by the researchers. Each workshop will have about 6-8 people in it and will take about **1.5 hours of your time**.

The workshops will take place in **Christchurch** between October 2022 and March 2023. While we will not be able to pay for your transportation, we will give you a **\$200 Voucher** to offset your costs and to acknowledge your contribution.

### Who can take part?

We are looking for a wide range of people to participate:

- **People who require in-home community support workers**
  - **Family/whānau members of people who require in-home community support workers**
  - **People working as community support workers**
- You need to be older than 18 years of age.
  - You will need to be able to communicate in a workshop situation (with/or without support). However, we can provide someone to support you with communication if you require this.

By community support worker, we mean anybody who provides paid assistance to people who live with disability in the community. This includes anyone working for an agency, or who works privately.
